





ASummer Tarland

A warm welcome to this concert of music for a summer evening, which includes pieces written for the Coronation and Golden Jubilee of Queen Elizabeth II.

Finzi's White Flowering Days appeared in a collection of choral songs entitled A Garland for the Queen, with contributions from ten contemporary composers and poets in Coronation year, 1953. The collection emulates The Triumphs of Oriana, madrigals written in 1601 to honour the first Queen Elizabeth, and Choral Songs in Honour of Her Majesty Queen Victoria from 1899.

Britten's opera *Gloriana* was also written to mark the Coronation in 1953, depicting the relationship between Elizabeth I and the Earl of Essex. The premiere was underrehearsed and not a critical success, but a symphonic suite and the *Choral Dances* which we shall be singing tonight have become popular stand-alone concert pieces.

Bullard's A Summer Garland was commissioned and first performed by the Waltham Singers as part of a Queen's Golden Jubilee project entitled A New Garland for the Queen. It portrays the varying moods of summer, from buzzing flies to calm evenings, and from May-blossom to fancy dress parades.

Refreshments will be served during the interval at the back of the church. If you'd like to take the Writtle sound home with you (or share it with others!), look out for our CDs that will be on sale. Do also look at the opportunities to sing with us - details of these and other future events are included in this programme.
